


3.D. THE PERIOD UNTIL THE CONTINENTAL SYSTEM 1803 - 1806

ENGLAND - GERMANY

Depending on weather or war circumstances different ports were used by the English packet boats. From April 1806 until April 1807, Husum was used again as connection with Harwich.



1 April 1806 London - Berlin

Postage paid in London according to the British tariff of March 1805: 3/- (3 shilling) for a double letter from England → Northern Europe (written *pd 3/* in the upper right corner and the under left corner).

Postage due in Berlin 9 1/2 Gute Groschen for a double letter (3 skilling Husum → Hamburg).
