ENGLAND - GERMANY

6 December 1809 London - Berlin

Postage paid in London
according to the British tariff of March 1805:
1/6 (1 shilling 6 pence) for a single letter
from England → Northern Europe
(written *pd 1/6* in the under left corner).

Postage due in Berlin
9 1/2 *Gute Groschen*
for a double letter
(3 *skilling* Husum → Hamburg).



Route: London - Harwich - Husum - Hamburg - Berlin

The number 191 is the Danish serial number written on each letter coming from abroad.
That number usually was written on the back.
