Postage paid in London according to the British turiff of March 1805; 1/6 (1 shilling 6 pence) for a single letter from England → Northern Europe (written pd 1/6 in the under left corner). Postage due in Berlin 9 1/2 Gute Groschen for a double letter (3 skilling Husum → Hamburg).



Route: London - Harwich - Human - Hamburg - Berlin

The number 191 is the Danish serial number written on each letter coming from abroad. That number usually was written on the back.
